 according to the reglent of the said churche. And I wchse if them the said tenuants make
 the same amys mychel daughter holme the daughter shall happen to her decesse in maner
 of her exchayber lawfully begettes or her brothe then I wchse that the surviving
 of them shall have and enioy all the said legimation or dappys heire lawly and tenementes
 with their appertainances to theyf of him or her that shall see surviver and to the best
 of his exchayber lawfully to be gettene according to the ryghtnes of the said maner
 And if theyf that both happen to her decesse without kinde of her beddes lawfully to be held
 in them my chayber and will that such other childer or children as my neare maner
 melle. And mother alreadyn that have livinges at the tyme of her decesse shall have
 held and enioy all the said legimation or dappys heire lawly and tenementes with their appa-
 rances to the yfel of him her or them or of her heire or their heires heires according
 to the ryghtnes of the said maner. And my will and minde is asunder of dappys heire
 will dapple and devide it to be that if my said neare maner melle the mother
 shall have no chayber or children livinges at the tyme of her decesse so that if such thise
 or children as that have livinges at her death and which by the time maner
 of that we my ought to have and enioy my said dappys heire lawly and tenementes shall
 all felow happen to her or herde without kinde of any of them heires lawfully to be
 begetten that then in either of these cases either Euillman John Sulien of Shrewsbury
 athenemans shall have and after the death and decesson of the said Euillman John Sulien and
 my wife and her decesson of all thise children without kinde of any of them
 lawfully to be gettene at about thare haire and enioy all oure decesse my said chay-
 ber and dappys heire lawly and tenementes with their appertainances to her and for
 to her sonnes to the yfel of her the said John Sulien and of his heires from thenceforth
 for ever accordinge to the ryghtnes of the said maner. And I desirably wchse all dappys
 will all remayne to herde to her decesson decesson and bequeathes by me heire before my de-
 cease and this to stande as her decesson and as my will and for her to be accompanied. In witness
 whereof I the said George Dyer have to this my present testimente and last will ren-
 dered written theron and myne shewes thereto and papers with this last shewe of my hand
 and seal sealed theron and sealed right above written. Signed, sealed, delivered and published
 and witnessed by the said George Dyer, before me his selfe will and Testament the day
 and year aforesaid of the presence of Mr Thomas Beck, William Fletcher, John Fletcher
 John Lavers and John Poynter.
